Parents' statutory right of appeal to an independent appeal panel

Parents of children refused admission by the Governing Body of Eden Boys' School have a statutory right of appeal to an independent appeal panel. Parents can either request an appeal form from the school or complete the appeal form from the Lancashire County Council website.

Primary to secondary transfer appeals under the normal admissions round for 2018 admissions

If parents of children return the completed appeal form to the school by 27th April 2018, then Lancashire County Council will arrange for the appeal to be heard by an independent appeal panel within 40 school days.

If the appeal form is returned to the school after 27th April 2018, then Lancashire County Council will arrange for the appeal to be heard by an independent appeal panel within 40 school days, where possible, or within 30 school days of the appeal form being lodged.

The appeals are likely to take place on 7th June 2018.

In-year admission appeals

In-year admission is the process for applying for admission into an existing year group.

When parents of children return the completed appeal form to the school, then Lancashire County Council will arrange for the appeal to be heard by an independent appeal panel within 30 school days of the appeal form being lodged.
