What a fantastic half term it has been! Our Pastoral newsletter provides a snapshot of all the amazing activities and work that has taken place at the school during the term.



#### **Attendance**

#### **Ramadhan Reflections**

#### Seerah Event



The Seerah is the beloved life of Our Prophet Muhammed (Peace and Salutations be upon him). Pupils will continue to be guided to prepare a three-minute speech to deliver during form time. Form tutors will act as judges to select the pupil who delivers the best speech. Judgement criteria will include looking at the structurer, content and relevance/authenticity of research which goes into the planning and preparation.

## **Key Dates:**

13<sup>th</sup> May – 21<sup>st</sup> May: pupils prepare speech.

22<sup>nd</sup> May – 9<sup>th</sup> June: students will deliver speeches in their morning form-time groups. 12<sup>th</sup> June: each tutor to select one student from all pupils who have delivered. 20 pupils in total will go through to the semi-final.

12<sup>th</sup> June – 22<sup>nd</sup> June: the 20 semifinalists will present speeches to a panel of judges and the 4 best speeches will be chosen for the grand-final on Friday 30<sup>th</sup> June.
